



Certificate Program in Integrative Health & CAM Therapies: Christian & / or Energetic Pathways to Health & Wellness

Part 1 Pathways to Health & Wellness Christian & / or Energetic Pathways

During this course the student can experience interventions from a variety of energetic approaches such as: Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine, Healing Touch, Reiki, Therapeutic Touch, Energy Medicine, Touch for Health, Energy Psychology, Yogi, Tai Chi or Qi Gong, Sound Healing, Dance, Movement Therapy & Creative Arts, Bio Energetic Wellness.

Includes identifying and documenting the persons health status including body, mindemotion and spiritual aspects. Through this in-depth analysis, the student explores their own energetic, family, and cultural imprinting that currently is affecting his / her journey. Once identified includes learning ways and strategies to break patterns that influence health and well-being.

Ethical dimensions in providing integrative care is explored.

Part 2 Applying what was learned to the population / certificate of choice

This usually taken 6 months to a year to complete and provides the documentation of the journey to complete your work. It is done online as well as in person with peers after we are permitted to travel and connect in person.

The person will be awarded a Certificate in Integrative Health and CAM Therapy as a Coach / Clinician, Practitioner / Facilitator or Specialist / Educator

Part 3 Reflection and Your Story

The training the person submit their credentials to the Akamai University, Institute For CAM Studies for awarding the Certificate and Continuing Education Units. The CAM Academy issues board certification.

Eligible Participants for the Training: The training is open to anyone desiring to receive a Certificate in Integrative Health and CAM Therapy as a coach / clinician, practitioner / facilitator or specialist / educator depending on the path you choose and your background. This training is foundational for those who desire to be teachers of this program and mentors. Can be applied to degree programing.

Program Fees:

Total program Cost Varies Depending on the Role:

Coach / Clinician \$1600, Practitioner / Facilitator \$1800, Specialist / Educator \$2100. Includes university continuing education with international accreditation, learning modules, spiritual development, mentorship, and certificate. Total of minimum of 9 to 12 CEU's to receive the certificate. Additional fees may be charged for additional mentorship to complete the program as needed beyond the basic program. All fees are payable to the Institute for CAM Studies. Includes University credit through Akamai University Division of Continuing Education. After each segment contact hours will be awarded documenting the segment taken and the number of contact hours. Payment options are available. Part I training also available as stand-alone costs without registration for the whole program A repeater fee for courses and modules is one/half the cost of each segment. Limited scholarships are available for those in need. Flexible monthly.
