Description: The CAM Specialist Training Program serving veterans and their families is offered through Akamai University Division of Continuing Education and the Institute for CAM Studies. The program is designed for those interested in a professional training certificate for clinical practice and / or clinical teaching in working with veterans and their families to help them heal, become empowered and integrate back into life.

Goal: Become a Board-Certified in Integrative Health Serving Veterans & their Families (BCIH – Serving Veterans & Families)

Continuing Education Units: The CAM Specialist Program "Serving Veterans & Families" consists of 18 CEU's (Continuing Education Units) or a minimum of 180 - 200 contact hours of study, reflection, training, practice and mentorship that lead to a BCIH - Serving Veterans & Families.

Curriculum:

 Part I – Foundational Energy Based Training 9 CEU's = 90 to 100 contact hour minimum (Can transfer completed certificate training from an approved energy modality such as Healing Touch, Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine, Touch For Health, Reiki, Etc.*

- Introductory seminar = 3 contact hours
- Initial Energy Healing Based Training* = 60 contact hours
- Initial Practical Supervised Application = 30 contact hours
- Part II Preparation for Specialist Training (9 CEU's = 90 to 100 contact hours)
 - Specialist Development, & Interventions = 16 contact hours (2 days)
 - o Specialist Practicum 16 hours minimum outlining previous training (2 days)
 - Mentorship = 20 contact hours' minimum + project 20 contact hours after practicum
- Part III Certificate through the CAM Academy Affiliated with Institute of CAM Studies of Akamai University – Documentation of your Specialist Training as verified by a professional project or paper outlining your specialty 10 contact hours & Professional Ethics Course 1 CEU = 10 contact hours

*Initial energy based training is foundational to specialist track. A student either comes into the program with this training or takes it as Part I foundational energetic care. It could be the Healing Touch Program, Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine, Reiki, Yoga, Touch For Health, Optimal Health, Integrative Medicine, Donna Eden Energy Medicine, Barbara Brennan or Rosalyn Buyere to mention a few.

Descriptions of CAM Specialist Training Program

Introductory Course to "I Serve Those Who Served" Training

This three-hour course gives an overview of the training involved to become certified in working with veterans and their families. It helps to make a decision if this is a specialty to pursue and become part of a network of individuals committed to work with this population. The military and their families are greatly affected often by their experience in service. This training is one attempt to provide energetic support to this population.

Part 1 Goal: Foundational Energy Based Training

During this course the student will build on his / her professional training in the health care field or another field, apply energy based therapies from previous training such as Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine, Healing Touch, Reiki, Subtle Communication Systems, Therapeutic Touch, Energy Medicine, Touch for Health, Energy Psychology, Yogi, Tai Chi or Qi Gong, Sound Healing, Life Coaching, Naturopathy, and other eligible completed energy training. Includes also energetic self-care to then apply to clients, Explore the ethical dimensions in providing energy based care. Define your spiritual growth and healing needs. Complete supervised mentorship. Professionally demonstrate your growth. The student can take a primary unit in Healing Touch, Energy Medicine or Touch For Health at the same time as part of the specialist training.

Part 2 CAM Specialist Training

This includes an introduction to Dr. Mary Jo Bulbrook's specialty, <u>Soul Healing</u> - an exciting in-depth opportunity to explore blocks to your personal journey in life as well as opening the door to increase your healing abilities and Soul Light. This theory and practice uses the students / clients own spiritual framework to produce changes in the energy system. Builds an understanding of the energetic elements in spiritual development.

Part 3 Certification

The program usually taken 6 months to a year to complete to integrate the training and apply the necessary documentation of expertise. Some of the training can be done on line as well as in person with peers. The person will be awarded the title Board Certified Integrative Healing (BCIH) CAM Specialist Serving Veterans & Families.

Program Fees:

If you transfer in basic completed foundational training of a minimum of 6 - 9 CEU's (60 - 90 hours) the fee is \$1800 or \$2500 for 18 continuing education units if you do not have energy-based training coming into the program.

Training includes 16 continuing education units with international accreditation, core specialist training working with veterans and their families, specialty modules, spiritual alignment & development, mentorship and certificate. Total minimum contact hours of 180 - 200 contact hours to receive the Board-Certified Integral Health as a CAM Certified Specialist Certificate "Serving Veterans & Families". All fees are payable to Institute for CAM Studies. Includes University credit through Akamai University Division of Continuing Education. After each segment contact hours will be awarded documenting the segment taken and the number of contact hours. Payment options are available. Part I training also available as stand-alone costs without registration for the whole program. A repeater fee for courses and modules is one/half the cost of each segment.
